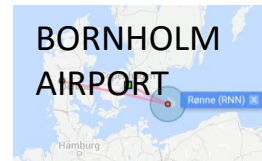


## AALBORG AIRPORT

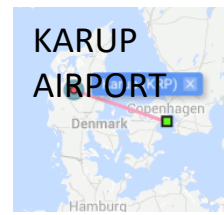

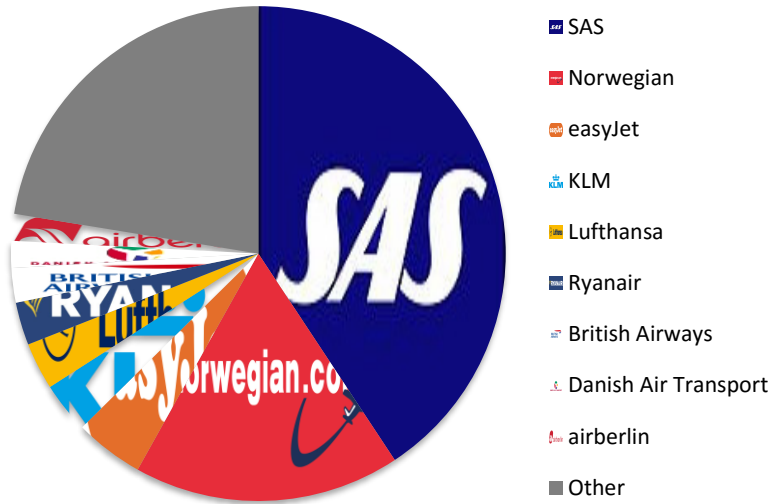

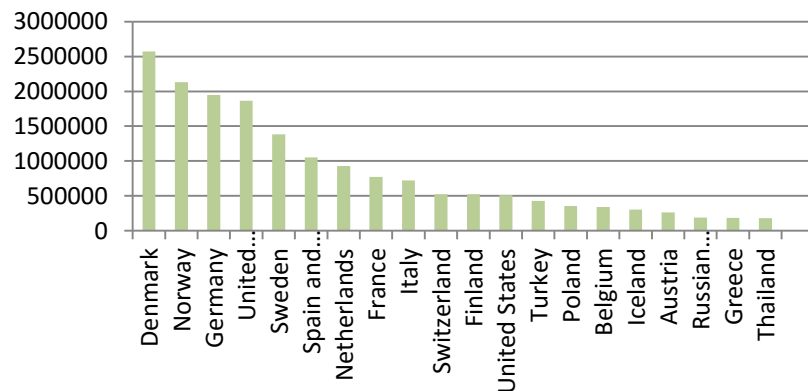

## REGULATION



- 2010 all Aviation regulation was put together with other transport modes into Danish Transport Authority

## AIR TRAFFIC CONTROL

- 2001 ATC was moved into a separate state owned company from the Danish Aviation Authorities
  - Area control in Denmark
  - Approach control on selected Airports

- Danish state owns 39,2 % of the CPH Airport
- Danish Transport Authority owns and operates Bornholms Airport (RNN)

## STRATEGIES & FINANCE

- No PSO-routes in use
- Strategy published in 2012, some focus areas:
  - European and Global Accessibility
  - CPH as a Nordic hub
  - Effective domestic traffic: regional airports are crucial for local communities
  - Different transport modes: good road and rail connections to the airports
